Dear Residents

We recently became aware that Scottish Borders Council (SBC) has additional pencil bollards available like those you may have already seen at crossings in Eyemouth that are frequently used by children, therefore we wanted to see if there were any appropriate crossings in Coldingham that might benefit from these bollards for our children's safety.

In conjunction with the Coldingham Primary Parents & Friends Association (PFA), and others, a number of locations in Coldingham were proposed to SBC for consideration. Representatives from Traffic & Road Safety at SBC visited Coldingham last month, along with one of our SBC Councillors, to review these locations using their safety assessment criteria.

This letter is to inform the Community of the proposals recommended by SBC, as detailed at the bottom and on the attached map. We intend to discuss these at the Community Council meeting on 21st April; please feel free to attend the meeting and share your views.

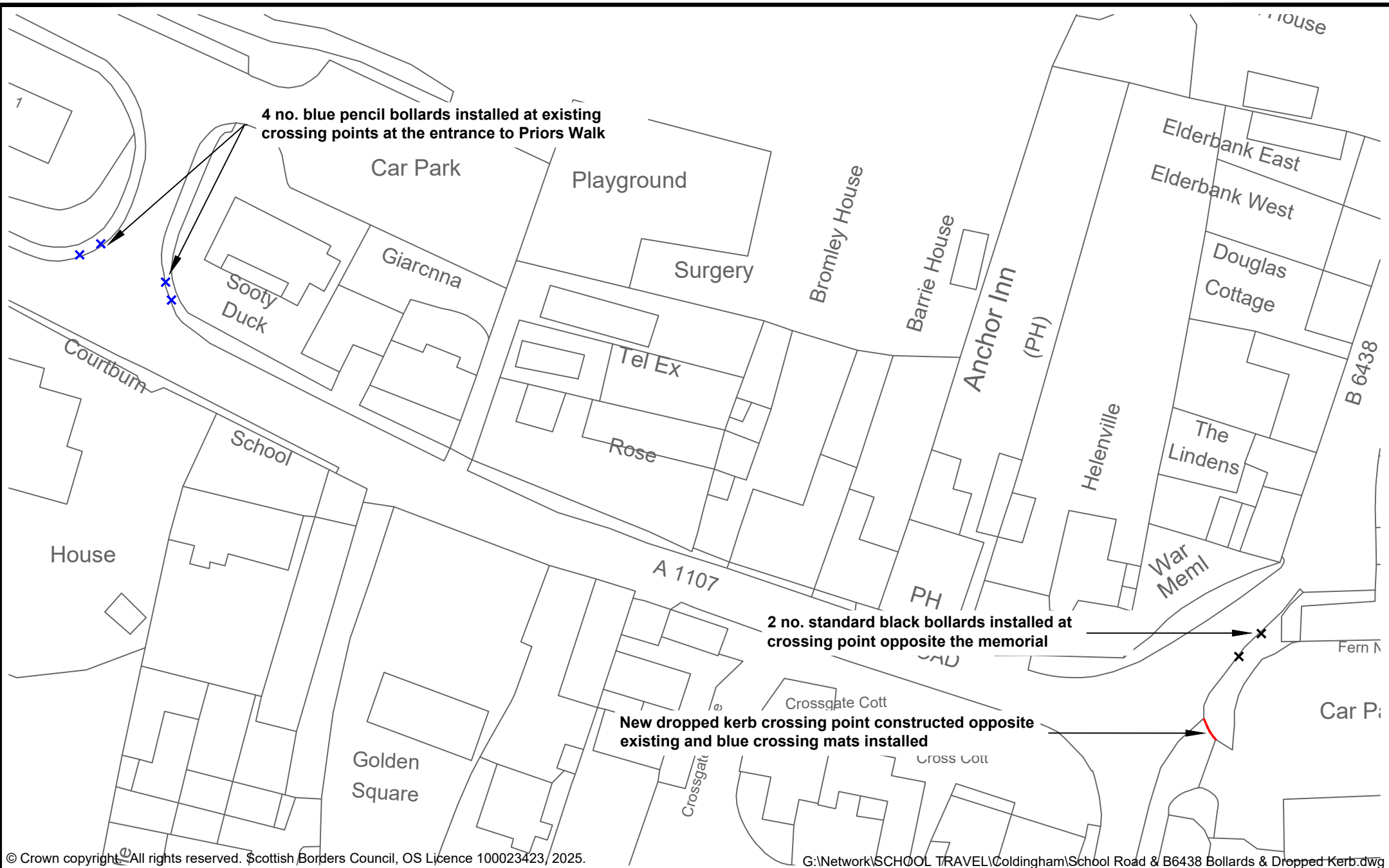

SBC recommendations:

- The installation of pencil bollards at the junction where Priors Walk meets School Road, where there is already a children's crossing marked
- The installation of black bollards on one side of the road at the existing children's crossing opposite the War Memorial*
- At the car park entrance next to the Village Hall; the installation of a dropped kerb on the side opposite the bus stop, and then and Stop, Look and Listen crossing mats on both sides at the dropped kerbs

* SBC and the CCC discussed at length the suitability of installing bollards close to a pinch point where congestion often occurs. From SBC's road safety perspective their view was that there is therefore an increased need for bollards at this location for children's safety.
