Matters Arising : Speeding – still trying to get police/ SBC assistance / input. Flooding at Eastlaw area still problematic, appears to be springs / field drains. RG passed round draft copies of application forms and guidelines to be used in the future for Penmanshiel money after the X has been concluded. If no changes, this will, with a copy of the CCC constitution and answers to various questions, be forwarded to the appropriate agency.

Treasurer's report : NW advised that nothing forthcoming as yet re further assistance towards the extra £500 required to cover strimming costs. Bank account otherwise healthy.

Police Report – No report available

SBC Cllrs Reports – In the absence of SBC councillors discussion centred around the temporary nature of pothole repairs, mainly due to heavy rains washing the temp filling back out. Dogs on the beach in summer time still an issue. Signage for this and possibly for top of the Creel Path would be advantageous before the main holiday periods if possible. No further word re playpark – main issue is insurance/liability etc. PW reported the state of the playpark round the swings etc - seriously dug up by tracked vehicles.

AOCB :Defib training mentioned again. ET offered to contact the chap who carried it out the last time, but she has also been able to speak with a couple currently living in the village with robust medical training/knowledge and experience. Agreed if possible she should pursue this.
