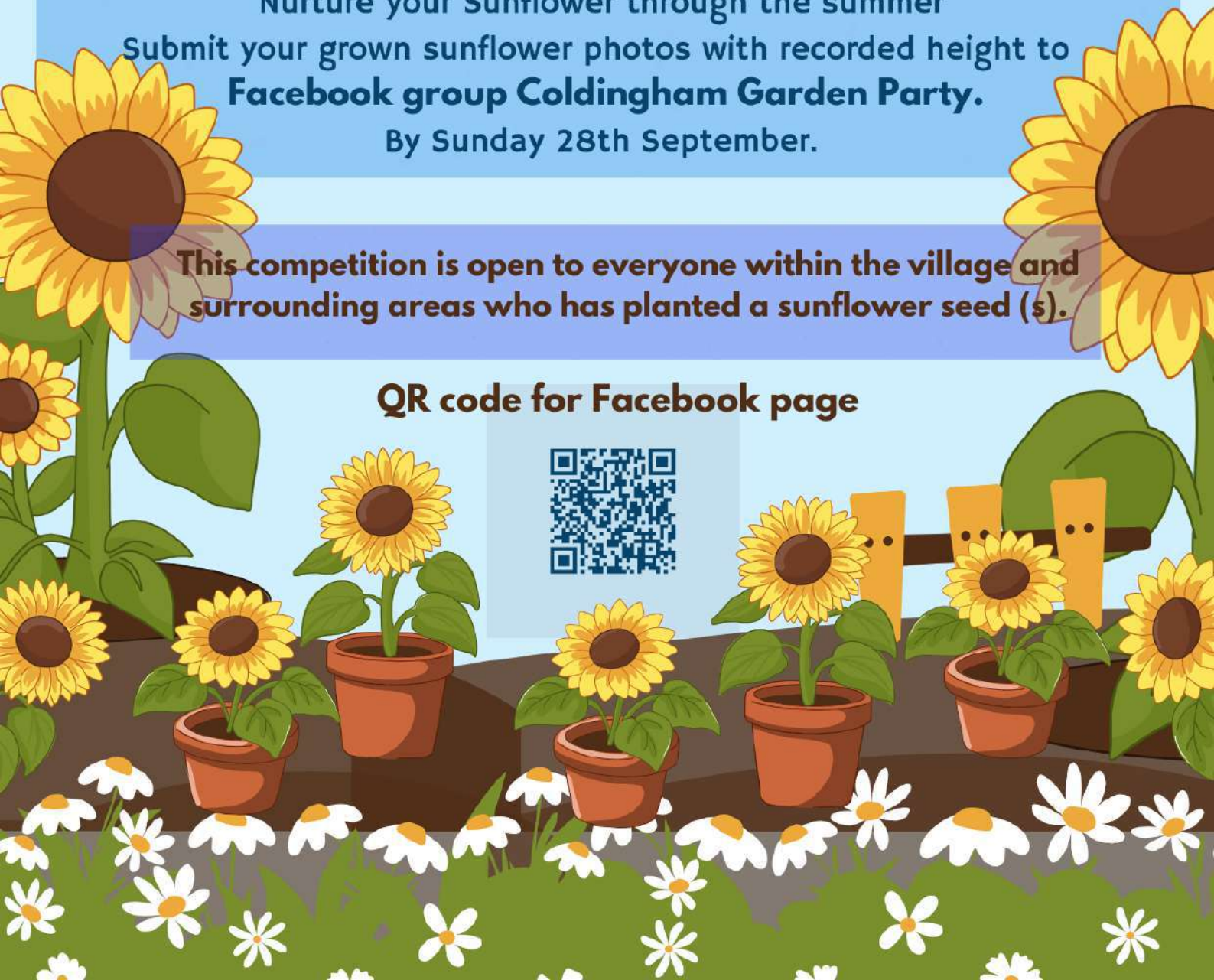
Nurture your Sunflower through the summer

As you may already know, Coldingham Garden Party are a small, entirely voluntary group of individuals, who maintain the green areas in Coldingham. Once a year we hold a plant sale which benefits a local charity and provides the funds for us to maintain our planters and sites.

Each year we ask for donations of plants from the local community and sell them at a very small cost at our plant sale.

More than ever it is important to support our community, encourage gardening and time spent in nature.

It is our aim, in our small way, to help make gardening as accessible as possible, and facilitate the community to grow their own food, without the prohibitive cost.
